Committee Meeting - Minutes



7.30pm, 13 October 2020 - The Rose and Crown, Kings Langley

1) HVA Committee Update

Duncan gave an update on committee members and noted that an AGM will be held in due course.

It was noted that rules and fines in terms of teams having to pull out of leagues won't be enforced as strictly as with normal years due to unknown numbers and possibility of covid peak. It was reiterated that fines are in place to assist with ensuring teams meet deadlines but in terms of officiality of the league there will be more flexibility around teams retiring from leagues if required.

Krys noted that communications around fines need to be better.

Duncan noted that there are no rule changes for the 21/22 season and rules are available on the HVA site for all to view.

The X league introduced in 2019/20 will remain in place for 21/22 and will be suitable for teams that are maybe struggling with team make-up for the mens/womens divisions. This leagues was introduced as a development league with more relaxed rules in regards to team make-up. It can be used by members of teams that wouldn't otherwise be playing for league teams and the results go on the HVA website but fixtures aren't set for the season and are organised similar to friendly matches.

2) Club registrations

It was noted that registrations were only received from Watford and MK. Awaiting other teams.

All teams need to complete and send through their Volleyball England registration.

ACTION: Duncan to send Hassan form for Fireball Phoenix team to register.

3) Fees

Entry fees will be reduced to £25 for league teams and remain at £10 for cup entries. X league teams will now be charged £25.

It was agreed that Fireball Phoenix will be charged a student rate of £12.50 per league team and £10 for a cup entry.

The goodwill deposit stays at £30 and fines are reduced from that. If teams use up the £30 during the season this will need to be topped up.

Invoices to be sent by Marzena and need to be paid before 1st match is played.

5) Fixtures

It was noted that Fireball Phoenix are a new and junior team and their facilities may not meet the exact standards as set out in the HVA rules in terms of net and ceiling height etc. It was noted that teams in Mens Div 2 will need to work with Fireball Phoenix to ensure they agree on the facilities or to offer to host 'Away' games at their home venue.

ACTION: John to send Duncan Google Docs link and Duncan to send out to fixtures leads.

6) Pre-Requisites for teams to play

All teams must have completed the following before playing their first match in 21/22

- Sent Duncan the registration form for the HVA league
- Sent Duncan their Volleyball England registration document for the 21/22 season
- Paid their invoice to HVA for league and cup entry as well as ensuring they have a £30 goodwill balance on account.

7) AOB

a. Match Balls

Luton noted that clubs are all using different versions of match balls and it would be good to have consistency across all teams.

Attendees agreed that all clubs in Men Div 1 and Ladies division must use a V200W match ball for matches.
